ATTIRE

Wearing the proper attire to all dance classes is highly recommended. Fitted dancewear helps the teacher see the dancers' lines. T-Shirts are NEVER allowed.

Creative Movement: 2-4 years old - Leotard, Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes, Black Tap Shoes

Optional Items - Dance Skirt or Shorts

Kinder Ballet & Tap: Leotard, Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes, Black Tap Shoes

Optional Items - Dance Skirt or Shorts

Elementary Ballet/Tap/Jazz Combo Class: 6-8 years old - Leotard, Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes, Black Tap Shoes, Tan Jazz Shoes

Optional Items - Dance Skirt or Shorts

Level 1-4 Ballet: - Leotard, Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes

Optional Items - Dance Skirt or Shorts

Level 1-4 Tap: Black Lace Up Tap Shoes, Any Fitted Dancewear (Example: Leotard, Leggings, Tank Top, Shorts)

Level 1-4 Jazz: Tan Jazz Shoes, Any Fitted Dancewear (Example: Leotard, Leggings, Tank Top, Shorts)

Level 1-4 Lyrical/Contemporary: Nude Half Sole Shoes, Any Fitted Dancewear (Example: Leotard, Leggings, Tank Top, Shorts)

Hip Hop: Kinder & up - Girls: Fitted Dancewear, Tennis Shoes or Jazz Shoes

Boys: Any Clothing you can Move Around In

Strength/Technique: Kinder & up - Fitted Dancewear, No Shoes

Pre-Acro & Acro: 3 years & up - Fitted Dancewear, Bare feet

Company: Kinder & Up - Black Dancewear, Proper Shoes

Boys: Solid Color Shorts & Top

All Classes: Hair must always be up and out of the dancer's face in a ponytail, bun, or braid. Bangs must be pinned back as well. Dancers must always wear the proper attire to class. Once the dancer starts level 1, you only need to wear tights in ballet.

POLICIES

1. While waiting in the lobby parents and dancers are expected to be quiet and respectful.
2. No gum, food, or drinks allowed inside the dance rooms (unless it's water with a lid).
3. Hair must always be up in a ponytail, bun, or braid.
4. Proper attire is required for all classes.
5. Regular attendance to classes is important to each student's development as a dancer. Make-up classes are available.
6. Large jewelry (hoop earrings, dangling necklaces, bracelets, etc.) is not allowed in dance class as it is a safety hazard to all dancers.

7. Students must wait inside the lobby until their parents pick them up. Parents of young children, please come inside the studio to pick your child up.
8. Our observation television is turned on for the first week of each month. We do not allow parents to sit in on the classes - it is a distraction to the dancer.
9. Please do not wear dance shoes outside as it can ruin the shoes.
10. If a parent is running late to pick up their child from dance, we ask that you call the studio to let us know.
11. If a child must miss dance class, please call our studio & let us know.
12. While classes are going on, we may not answer your phone call. Please leave us a message and we will return your call when our classes end.
13. Each dancer is placed in a class according to age & ability. This is so the dancer will learn at the pace he/she is comfortable at.
14. All students have the opportunity to perform in our Spring Recital. Costume fees are due in November, December, and January and a recital fee is due in February/March.
15. If there are any concerns about your child's progress, please let us know. We want your child to progress as a dancer just as much as you do.

PAYMENTS/ACCOUNTS

1. Tuition is due by the first of each month. After the 10th there is a \$10 late fee added to all accounts that are past due.
2. **NEW POLICY**: If you are signed up for AutoPay, there is a processing fee that will automatically be added into your monthly tuition cost. If you remove yourself from AutoPay, you will need to let the front office staff know so we can remove this additional fee. Processing Fees are as follows:
 - a. *\$5 fee* – Tuition between \$60-\$100/month
 - b. *\$10 fee* – Tuition between \$101-\$200/month
 - c. *\$12 fee* – Tuition between \$200-\$260/month
3. All accounts are to be kept up with. Any dancers' account past due for more than one month will be dropped from classes.
4. Recital is optional. Anyone who signs up to participate agrees to pay all fees, by their due dates that are included with recital. We send information home regarding recital in October/November.
5. **We do NOT give refunds for any reason unless classes are cancelled on our behalf and a makeup class isn't scheduled.**

MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS

Each month you will receive a newsletter with information about upcoming events, payments, etc. **Please check your email daily for the newsletter and other info.**

OTHER FEES/INFORMATION

1. We do not pro-rate tuition for any month. Your tuition is calculated based on the number of classes offered during the year. We then divide your total tuition by nine months to get your monthly payment amount. If we do not have a full month of classes, tuition is still the same amount as any other month.
2. Weekly lesson plans, class time, studio time (when dancers use studio to practice on their own), and dance choreography are all included in the price of tuition.
3. We charge \$1/minute for any child that is picked up more than 5 minutes late from their class. We have to pay staff to sit with your child while they wait.
4. In the event that a class has to be canceled due to a studio reason, we will schedule make-up classes on another day OR offer online classes via Zoom. If class is canceled due to weather or holidays, we do not schedule make-ups.
